**ENTRIES MUST BE SUBMITTED** with required entry fee on an Official American Kennel Club Entry Form. Entries

Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

**DOGS NEED TO BE AT THE SHOW** only at scheduled time for judging and may leave immediately thereafter, unless require for further judging.

**THE CLUB** reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value,

**OVERNIGHT RESERVATIONS**

Overnight available at a fee of \$90.00 per space for 2 nights (Friday & Saturday) and \$125.00 per space for 3 nights (Thurs., Fri., Sat.). Spaces are limited to 45 feet. A fee of \$25.00 per night will be charged for vehicles over 45 feet. All reservations will be in assigned spaces and only one vehicle permitted per space. - (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. Best of Breed Competition

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owners records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90 day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by AKC, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC.

Awards of Merit Both Varieties

At the Judge's discretion, an Award of Merit may be given to 10% (rounded upward) to those competing for Best of Variety. The 10% figure shall be based on the total entry in the Best of Variety Competition at the time of entry closing (disregarding any absences and transfers from the classes) plus an additional number for Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and the winners of Veterans Dog and Veterans Bitch Classes. The Award of Merit winners will be selected after the Best of Variety, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Variety and Best of Winners awards are made. All dogs remaining in competition are eligible for an Award of Merit.

New Class ~ Amateur ~ Owner ~ Handler

For dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog and is limited to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Best Puppy in Variety

Following the Best of Variety Competition the Judge will select a Best Puppy in Variety from the first place winners from the 6 to 9 months and the 9 to 12 month Puppy Classes. Should the dog/bitch selected Best of Variety and/or Best of Winners come from one of the Puppy Classes, it shall automatically become the Best Puppy in Variety. Should the dog/bitch selected Best of Opposite, and/or Winners Dog/Bitch or the Reserve Winners Dog/Bitch come from one of the Puppy Classes, it shall compete with the Puppy winners from the opposite sex for Best Puppy in Variety.

Best Bred-by-Exhibitor in Variety (BBE) and Class Eligibility

Following the Best of Variety Competition and the Best Puppy in Variety Competition, the first place Bred by Exhibitor Dog and the first place Bred by Exhibitor Bitch will compete for Best Bred By Exhibitor in Variety. Should the dog/bitch selected Best of Variety and/or Best of Winners come from the Bred by Exhibitor Class, it shall automatically become the Best Bred by Exhibitor in Variety.

Best Veteran in Variety

Following the Best of Variety Competition the judge will select a Best Veteran from the First Place Winners from the Dog and Bitch Class.

**STUD DOG CLASS:** For Stud Dogs and a minimum of two, maximum of five, of their Get. The award will be based on the merits of the get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not be the owner of the get.
