BEST OF BREED or BEST OF VARIETY COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owners records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90 day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by AKC, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC.

BEST PUPPY

Best in Puppy Classes. The First place puppy of each of the four Rough Puppy Classes (6-9 & 9-12 only) and the four Smooth Puppy Classes (6-9 & 9-12 only) are eligible to compete for this award. For the American Kennel Club definition of Puppy, Bred by Exhibitor, American Bred and Open Classes. See Chapter 3. "Rules Applying to Dog Shows."

NON-REGULAR CLASSES BOTH VARIETIES

Veteran Dogs and Veteran Bitches 7 years and older

Neutered Dogs and spayed bitches would be allowed to compete in the Veterans Classes only at Independent Specialties and/or those all breed shows which do not offer any competitive classes beyond Best of Breed.

HIGH DESERT COLLIE CLUB SWEEPSTAKES RULES

SWEEPSTAKES

- Eligibility:** Rough and Smooth Collie varieties combined. Puppy dogs and bitches (6mo-18mos). The first four placements in each class will be eligible for finalist placements. The 1st placement in each class shall compete for first finalist. After placement of 1st finalist the dog that was 2nd to the dog in its age class is then eligible to compete with the remaining first placement dogs for the next placement. Only 6 dogs shall be in the ring for final placement at one time. If for any reason the eligible dog is not available for judging, the next lower placement will be judged in its place.
- Classes:** Puppy Dog 6-9months; Puppy Dog 9-12 months; Dogs 12-18 months;
Puppy Bitch 6-9 months; Puppy Bitch 9-12 months; Bitches 12-18 months.
- Division of stakes:** 10% to be retained by HDCC for expenses; the remainder 90% of the stake shall be divide among the finalists as follows: 1st finalist, 40%; 2nd finalist, 30%; 3rd finalist, 20%; 4th finalist, 10%.
- Entries:** Dogs entered in the sweepstake must first be entered in one of the regular classes on the same entry form and marked "Sweepstakes" and age division in the Additional Class box on the entry form.

CHANGES, ADDITIONS, CORRECTIONS OR CANCELLATIONS to entry forms must be received in writing by U.S. Mail or by FAX. Signed and Dated by Owner or Agent prior to the close of entries. Not acceptable by Telephone.

ENTRIES MUST BE SUBMITTED with required entry fee on an Official American Kennel Club Entry Form.

Entries submitted in the form of telegrams or by telephone, cannot be accepted.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Judge, or barred from competition by action of the show committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entries fees for duplicate entry or overpayment of entry fees. If because of riots, civil disturbances, fire extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, and Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or another acts beyond the control of the Club or Show Secretary it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

AN ADMINISTRATIVE FEE of \$2.00 will be charged for all cancellations or changes made prior to closing of entries.

ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under the American Kennel Club rules shall be allowed on the show grounds and dogs excused form further judging are to be removed promptly.

ALL DOGS SHALL BE held on leash or confined to their crates, except when being judged or when being exercised.

THESE SHALL BE NO drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises.

DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club and its Show Secretary will not be responsible and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

DOGS NEED TO BE AT THE SHOW only at scheduled time for judging and may leave immediately thereafter, unless require for further judging.

THE CLUB reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

ALL TROPHIES must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed or otherwise distributed.

CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the persons showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that Breed is over and the Show Secretary's Office is advised at once. The Show Secretary and Show giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the Breed is over.

THE WELFARE OF AN EXHIBITOR'S CHILD is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. JUNIOR - A boy or girl who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show
INTERMEDIATE - A boy or girl who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on day of the show.
SENIOR - A boy or girl who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of show.

OPEN - This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, who have won 3 first place awards in a Novice Class in a licensed or member show, with competition present. The winner of a Novice Class shall automatically become eligible, upon notice to the Open Class ring steward, to enter and compete in the Open Class at the same show provided the win is the (3rd) first place award with competition and further providing that there are one or more Junior Handlers competing in the Open Class.
