CHAPTER 11, SECTION 1.

No dog shall be exhibited in a licensed or member dog show, except for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class unless it is either individually registered in the AKC Stud Book, or individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration. See <http://akc.org/pdfs/rulebooks/RREGS3.pdf> for complete detail of the rule change.

OVERNIGHT PARKING INFORMATION

KENNEL CLUB OF PALM SPRINGS ELECTRICAL POWER INFORMATION:

POWER WILL BE AVAILABLE IN OVERNIGHT PARKING AREAS ONLY.

The POWER FEE is \$40.00 (for 30 amps) or \$80.00 (for 60 amps) per night 2-night minimum.

Power will be available from 3 PM Wednesday through Best in Show on Sunday.

*Requests for power not made in advance, will be \$10.00 more (cash), per night.

Please make your check payable to Event Power Solutions, but mail it to Ron Mattson. You may use your own generator if you so choose. NOTE: Overnight

Parking will be limited to 400 reservations. Assignments to parking lots will be made in the order that reservations are received.

NO PARKING or ELECTRICAL POWER REFUNDS WILL BE MADE AFTER THE CLOSING DATE.

There are three overnight parking areas: two are adjacent to the show area and one is some distance away.

Most of the parking is on decomposed granite. One limited area is on grass, weather permitting. Vehicles parked on grass will be required to have ground cover placed under their generators and exhaust pipes to protect the grass. No dumping of gray water or sewage is allowed.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owners records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90 day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by AKC, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC.

AMATEUR ~ OWNER ~ HANDLER

For dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog and is limited to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13). *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay.*

AWARD(S) OF MERIT

At the conclusion of Best of Breed, after picking Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, the Specialty Judge at his/her discretion may award Rosettes for Judges Awards of Merit to a maximum of 10% of the Best of Breed entry. The judge is not obligated to award any Awards of Merit if he/she feels there are not any dogs or bitches in competition worthy of this award. All dogs competing in the Best of Breed competition are eligible for this award with exception of the Best of Breed winner.

BEST PUPPY FROM THE REGULAR CLASSES

Best Puppy will be selected from the First Place Winners of the 6-9 mos. and 9-12 mos. Classes, Dogs and Bitches.

BEST VETERAN

The judge will select a Best Veteran from the First Place Winners from the Dog and Bitch Class

Any person that issues a check that is returned for non-payment, will be required to pay a fine of \$25.00 per check and all items with which check or checks were issued shall then be paid by cash, money, or cashier's check.

CONDITIONAL, UNSIGNED, INCOMPLETE ENTRIES received without fees will not be accepted. **OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE** for errors on entry blanks and for entering the same dog twice. No refunds for duplicate entries. **ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC FORMS** or photocopies of entry forms without rules and agreement on reverse side of Official AKC entry form are NOT acceptable.

CHANGES, ADDITIONS, CORRECTIONS OR CANCELLATIONS to entry forms must be received in writing by U.S.Mail, Telegram, or by FAX, Signed and Dated by Owner or Agent prior to the close of entries. Not acceptable by Telephone. **ENTRIES MUST BE SUBMITTED** with required entry fee on an Official American Kennel Club Entry Form. Entries submitted in the form of telegrams or by telephone, cannot be accepted.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Judge, or barred from competition by action of the show committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entries fees for duplicate entry or overpayment of entry fees. If because of riots, civil disturbances, fire extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, and Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or another acts beyond the control of the Club or Show Secretary it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

AN ADMINISTRATIVE FEE OF \$2.00 will be charged for all cancellations or changes made prior to closing of entries. **ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE** to be shown under the American Kennel Club rules shall be allowed on the show grounds and dogs excused form further judging are to be removed promptly.

ALL DOGS SHALL BE held on leash or confined to their crates, except when being judged or when being exercised.

THERE SHALL BE NO drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises.

DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club and its Show Secretary will not be responsible and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

DOGS NEED TO BE AT THE SHOW only at scheduled time for judging and may leave immediately thereafter, unless require for further judging.

THE CLUB reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value,

ALL TROPHIES must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed or otherwise distributed.

CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the persons showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that Breed is over and the Show Secretary's Office is advised at once. The Show Secretary and Show giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the Breed is over.

THE WELFARE OF AN EXHIBITOR'S CHILD is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the show. For everyone's safety, no baby strollers or wheeled child carriers are allowed on the show grounds.

ALL PERSONS ATTENDING THIS DOG SHOW hereby waive any claim for damages against **SAN FERNANDO VALLEY DOBERMAN PINSCHER CLUB**, its members, or agents, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

SAN FERNANDO VALLEY DOBERMAN PINSCHER CLUB, IT'S SHOW SECRETARIES, THEIR AGENTS, EMPLOYEES, ETC. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Dogs entering mixed breed classes (eligible only in standalone Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials) should mark Breed as "MIXED BREED." Variety, Breeder, Sire, Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
