AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE

From Westlake Village/San Fernando Valley on the 101 Freeway

Take the 101 Freeway to the 23 North

When you get to Moorpark, get off at Tierra Rejada Road.

Turn Left onto Tierra Rejada Road

Turn Left onto Sunset Valley Road

Sunset Valley Road goes straight for about a mile. Then the road makes a sharp right hand turn. At this curve in the road, turn Left onto Read Road.

The training site is about 1/4 mile on the left.

Once you're on Read Road, you can't miss the site. You'll see the equipment on the left.

If you go too far, the road dead ends.

From Simi Valley/San Fernando Valley

Take the 118 to the 23 freeway

Exit at Tierra Rejada Road and turn Right at the end of the ramp.

Turn Left onto Sunset Valley Road.

Follow the above directions from Sunset Valley Road.

From Camarillo/Ventura

Take the 101 and exit at Santa Rosa Road.

Turn Left onto Santa Rosa Road (Away from the Ocean)

Santa Rosa Road goes about 10 miles, through the Santa Rosa Valley.

Watch for the street sign for Andalusia Road. Moorpark Road is shortly after this street.

Turn Left onto Moorpark Road

At top of hill turn right on Read Road

Read Road goes straight for a while. It will then make a sharp left hand curve (15 mph signs posted).

At this curve in the road, go STRAIGHT.

The training site is about 1/4 mile down Read Road on the left.

Once you're on Read Road, you can't miss the training site. If you go too far, the road dead ends.

POST DATED AND RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. The returned check **MUST BE MADE GOOD** by cash or money order **BEFORE** the dog(s) will be allowed in the ring. Any person that issues a check that is returned for non-payment, will be required to pay a fine of \$25.00 per check and all items with which check or checks were issued shall then be paid by cash, money, or cashier's check.

CONDITIONAL, UNSIGNED, INCOMPLETE ENTRIES received without fees will not be accepted.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors on entry blanks and for entering the same dog twice. No refunds for duplicate entries.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC FORMS or photocopies of entry forms without rules and agreement on reverse side of Official AKC entry form are **NOT** acceptable.

CHANGES, ADDITIONS, CORRECTIONS OR CANCELLATIONS to entry forms must be received in writing by U.S. Mail, or by FAX, Signed and Dated by Owner or Agent prior to the close of entries. Not acceptable by Telephone.

ENTRIES MUST BE SUBMITTED with required entry fee on an Official American Kennel Club Entry Form. Entries submitted in the form of telegrams or by telephone, cannot be accepted.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Judge, or barred from competition by action of the show committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entries fees for duplicate entry or overpayment of entry fees. If because of riots, civil disturbances, fire or extreme dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or other acts beyond the control of the Club or Show Secretary it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under the American Kennel Club rules shall be allowed on the show grounds and dogs excused from further judging are to be removed promptly.

ALL DOGS SHALL BE held on leash or confined to their crates, except when being judged or when being exercised.

THERE SHALL BE NO drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises.

DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club and its Show Secretary will not be responsible and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

DOGS NEED TO BE AT THE SHOW only at scheduled time for judging and may leave immediately thereafter, unless required for further judging.

THE CLUB reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value,

ALL TROPHIES must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed or otherwise distributed.

CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the persons showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that Breed is over and the Show Secretary's Office is advised at once. The Show Secretary and Show giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the Breed is over.

THE WELFARE OF AN EXHIBITOR'S CHILD is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the show. For everyone's safety, no baby strollers or wheeled child carriers are allowed on the show grounds.

ALL PERSONS ATTENDING THIS DOG SHOW hereby waive any claim for damages against **TRI-VALLEY SHETLAND SHEEPDOG CLUB OF NORTHWEST LOS ANGELES**, its members, or agents, in the event a motor vehicle must enter to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owners records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90 day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by AKC, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC.

AMATEUR OWNER HANDLER

(January 1, 2009, AKC Dog Show Rules, Chapter 3, Section 3 and Section 7)

The Amateur-Owner-Handler class shall be for dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13). *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers/organization, distributed rate cards or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay.*

GRAND CHAMPION SELECT

When quality warrants, after BOB and BOS are awarded, a Select Dog (SD) and Select Bitch (SB) may be chosen from the remaining Champions (Non Regular Class winners that are Champions and Qualify for BOB are eligible) - (WD or WB are not eligible) (AKC Dog Show Rules, Chapter 3, Section 14 Effective 5-12-10)

AWARDS OF MERIT

The judge may give an Award of Merit at his/her discretion to 10% of the Shetland Sheepdogs entry in the Best of Breed Competition. This includes Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch, Performance Dog and Bitch. This award goes to Shetland Sheepdogs that the judge feels possess excellence in the Breed
