Any person that issues a check that is returned for non-payment, will be required to pay a fine of \$25.00 per check and all items with which check or checks were issued shall then be paid by cash, money, or cashier's check.

CONDITIONAL, UNSIGNED, INCOMPLETE ENTRIES received without fees will not be accepted.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors on entry blanks and for entering the same dog twice. No refunds for duplicate entries. **ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC FORMS** or photocopies of entry forms without rules and agreement on reverse side of Official AKC entry form are NOT acceptable.

Not acceptable by Telephone.

ENTRIES MUST BE SUBMITTED with required entry fee on an Official American Kennel Club Entry Form. Entries submitted in the form of telegrams or by telephone, cannot be accepted.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Judge, or barred from competition by action of the show committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entries fees for duplicate entry or overpayment of entry fees. If because of riots, civil disturbances, fire extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, and Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or another acts beyond the control of the Club or Show Secretary it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

AN ADMINISTRATIVE FEE of \$2.00 will be charged for all cancellations or changes made prior to closing of entries.

ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under the American Kennel Club rules shall be allowed on the show grounds and dogs excused from further judging are to be removed promptly.

ALL DOGS SHALL BE held on leash or confined to their crates, except when being judged or when being exercised.

THERE SHALL BE NO drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises.

DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club and its Show Secretary will not be responsible and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

DOGS NEED TO BE AT THE SHOW only at scheduled time for judging and may leave immediately thereafter, unless require for further judging.

THE CLUB reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

ALL TROPHIES must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed or otherwise distributed.

CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the persons showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that Breed is over and the Show Secretary's Office is advised at once. The Show Secretary and Show giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the Breed is over.

OVERNIGHT RESERVATIONS

Overnight available at a fee of \$90.00 per space for 2 nights (Friday & Saturday) and \$125.00 per space for 3 nights (Thurs., Fri., Sat. or Fri., Sat., Sun.) and \$160.00 per space for 4 nights. Spaces are limited to 45 feet. A fee of \$25.00 per night will be charged for vehicles over 45 feet. All reservations will be in assigned spaces and only one vehicle permitted per space. There will be an additional charge for extra vehicles. Overnight parking will be on asphalt and all units must be self-contained. No waste or gray water is to be discharged onto the grounds.

LIMITED ELECTRICAL HOOKUPS WILL BE PROVIDED BY THE NATIONAL ORANGE SHOW EVENTS CENTER FOR AN ADDITIONAL CHARGE TO BE PAID AT THE GATE.

Best of Breed Competition

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owners records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90 day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by AKC, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC.

Awards of Merit Both Varieties

At the Judge's discretion, an Award of Merit may be given to 10% (rounded upward) to those competing for Best of Variety. The 10% figure shall be based on the total entry in the Best of Variety Competition at the time of entry closing (disregarding any absentees and transfers from the classes) plus an additional number for Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and the winners of Veterans Dog and Veterans Bitch Classes. The Award of Merit winners will be selected after the Best of Variety, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Variety and Best of Winners awards are made. All dogs remaining in competition are eligible for an Award of Merit.

Grand Champion Select

When quality warrants, after BOB and BOS are awarded, a Select Dog (SD) and Select Bitch (SB) may be chosen from the remaining Champions (Non Regular Class winners that are Champions and Qualify for BOB are eligible) - (WD or WB are not eligible) (AKC Dog Show Rules, Chapter 3, Section 14 Effective 5-12-10)

Amateur Owner Handler

The Amateur-Owner-Handler class shall be for dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13). Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers/organization, distributed rate cards or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay.

Best Puppy in Variety

Following the Best of Variety Competition the Judge will select a Best Puppy in Variety from the first place winners from the 6 to 9 months and the 9 to 12 month Puppy Classes. Should the dog/bitch selected Best of Variety and /or Best of Winners come from one of the Puppy Classes, it shall automatically become the Best Puppy in Variety. Should the dog/bitch selected Best of Opposite, and/or Winners Dog/Bitch or the Reserve Winners Dog/Bitch come from one of the Puppy Classes, it shall compete with the Puppy winners from the opposite sex for Best Puppy in Variety.

Best Bred-by-Exhibitor in Variety (BBE) and Class Eligibility

Following the Best of Variety Competition and the Best Puppy in Variety Competition, the first place Bred by Exhibitor Dog and the first place Bred by Exhibitor Bitch will compete for Best Bred By Exhibitor in Variety. Should the dog/bitch selected Best of Variety and /or Best of Winners come from the Bred by Exhibitor Class, it shall automatically become the Best Bred by Exhibitor in Variety.

Best Veteran in Variety

Following the Best of Variety Competition the judge will select a Best Veteran from the First Place Winners from the Dog and Bitch Class.

Best American Bred in Variety

Following the Best of Variety Competition the judge will select a Best American Bred from the First Place Winners from the Dog and Bitch Class

Non - Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

STUD DOG CLASS: For Stud Dogs and a minimum of two, maximum of five, of their Get. The award will be based on the merits of the get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not be the owner of the get. The Stud Dog must be entered in the "Stud Dog Class" and shown in the ring with his get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or exclusion under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a Regular class, Best of Variety Competition or some other Non-Regular Class.
BROOD BITCH CLASS: Same as Stud Dog Class, except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.
BRACE CLASS: This class shall be for two dogs (a unit) of the same breed or variety of breed, irrespective of sex, with at least one common owner and presented in the ring with no more than two handlers. The entry fee for a Brace as a unit, as listed on the official AKC form and at least one of the unit dogs must also be entered in some other class at this show. (A completed entry form must be submitted for each dog.) Show Brace Class in "Additional Entry" portion of the entry form. If more than one Brace is entered by identical owner, the dogs comprising EACH BRACE UNIT must be designated "Brace #1, Brace #2, etc.
