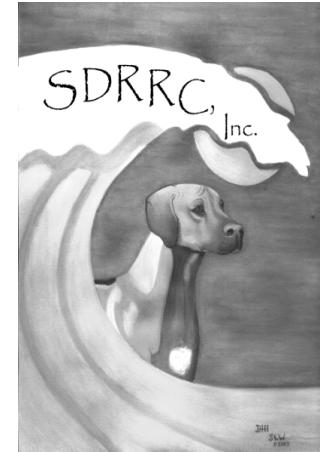

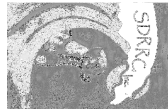

PALM SPRINGS OVERNIGHT PARKING INFORMATION - 2012

ELECTRICAL POWER INFORMATION:

ELECTRICAL POWER WILL BE AVAILABLE IN OVERNIGHT PARKING AREAS ONLY.

The POWER FEE per night is \$45.00 for 30 amps or \$90.00 for 50 amps-user to bring own adapter. 2 night minimum. Requests for power not made in advance, \$10.00 more (cash), per night Please make your check payable to Event Power Solutions, but mail it to Ron Mattson.

You may use your own generator if you so choose. Overnight Parking will be limited to 400 reservations.

Assignments to parking lots will be made in the order that reservations are received.

NO PARKING or ELECTRICAL POWER REFUNDS WILL BE MADE AFTER THE CLOSING DATE. IF YOU ARRIVE BEFORE 5 PM ON CHECK-N DAY AND PLUG INTO POWER, YOU WILL BE CHARGED FOR AN EXTRA DAY OF POWER USAGE, PER EVENT POWER SOLUTIONS.

There are three overnight parking areas: two are adjacent to the show area and one is some distance away. Most of the parking is on decomposed granite. One limited area is on grass, weather permitting. Vehicles parked on grass required to buy power; no generators are to be allowed on the grass, per Empire Polo Club. No dumping of gray water or sewage is allowed.

All parking reservations must be received by December 21, 2011

PARKING FEE IS \$40.00 PER SPACE, PER NIGHT.

Parking Hours: Wednesday: 3pm to 10pm Thursday: 6pm to 10pm Friday: 6am to 10pm

Saturday: 6am to 7am and after Best in Show to 10pm Sunday: 6am to 7am

Please note the following parking requirements/restrictions:

1. Those wishing to park together must arrive together.
2. Space changing will not be permitted. All vehicles must park as directed by parking personnel.
3. Confirmation of your reservation will be sent if you enclose a stamped, self-addressed envelope.
4. All personal generators must be turned off between 11 pm and 6 am daily.
5. All tag vehicles will be required to purchase a tag vehicle pass (\$20.00 for the weekend).
6. Tag vehicles must fit into assigned space (not in aisle), or be moved to day-of-show parking area.
7. Any motor home over 40' long must have two spaces.
8. Any truck & trailer over 40' must have two spaces, or unhook; note on form.
9. All parking spaces are 22' wide by 35' long; over 35' will be parked in designated rows.
10. No foul or abusive language will be tolerated; anyone not following parking rules will be asked to leave, and no refunds will be given.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owners records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90 day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by AKC, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC.

AWARD OF MERIT

The judge, at his/her discretion, may award in the ring (excluding the Best of Breed winner) up to 10% of the Best of Breed Entries to receive an Award of Merit. The Rhodesian Ridgebacks receiving this award will exhibit qualities that the judge feels are worthy of consideration for Best of Breed.

GRAND CHAMPION SELECT

When quality warrants, after BOB and BOS are awarded, a Select Dog (SD) and Select Bitch (SB) may be chosen from the remaining Champions (Non Regular Class winners that are Champions and Qualify for BOB are eligible) - (WD or WB are not eligible) (AKC Dog Show Rules, Chapter 3, Section 14 Effective 5-12-10)

AMATEUR - OWNER - HANDLER

For dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog and is limited to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13).

Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

Veteran Dog Class (Over 7 Years of Age) Veteran Bitch Class (Over 7 Years of Age)
Neutered Dogs and Spayed Bitches may compete in the Veterans Classes only at Independent Specialties.
(AKC Dog Show Rules, Chapter 14, Section 8)

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

NOTE: As the judges' decision in the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

***Stud Dog Class -** For Stud Dogs with at least two and no more than three of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC Policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition, or some other Non-Regular class.

***Brood Bitch Class -** Same as Stud Dog Class, except replace "Stud Dog" with "Brood Bitch" and "Get" with "Produce".
**Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class".*

Brace Class - Each Brace shall be composed of two RHODESIAN RIDGEBACKS with at least one common owner and presented in the ring with no more than two handlers. The dogs comprising the Brace must be named at the time of entry. Full particulars must be given for each dog on an individual entry form. If a dog that is to be part of a brace is entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace, specify "Brace Class" in the Additional Classes section of the form. If a dog is not entered in another class, specify "Brace Class Only" in the Dog Show Class section of the form. If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each Brace must be so designated, "Brace No. 1," "Brace No. 2," etc.

CHAPTER 11, SECTION 1. No dog shall be exhibited in a licensed or member dog show, except for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class unless it is either individually registered in the AKC Stud Book, or individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration. See <http://akc.org/pdfs/rulebooks/RREGS3.pdf> for complete detail of the rule change.

POST DATED AND RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. The returned check **MUST BE MADE GOOD** by cash or money order **BEFORE** the dog(s) will be allowed in the ring. Any person that issues a check that is returned for non-payment, will be required to pay a fine of \$25.00 per check and all items with which check or checks were issued shall then be paid by cash, money, or cashier's check.

CONDITIONAL, UNSIGNED, INCOMPLETE ENTRIES received without fees will not be accepted.
OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors on entry blanks and for entering the same dog twice. No refunds for duplicate entries.
ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC FORMS or photocopies of entry forms without rules and agreement on reverse side of Official AKC entry form are NOT acceptable.

CHANGES, ADDITIONS, CORRECTIONS OR CANCELLATIONS to entry forms must be received in writing by U.S. Mail, Telegram, or by FAX, Signed and Dated by Owner or Agent prior to the close of entries. Not acceptable by Telephone.

ENTRIES MUST BE SUBMITTED with required entry fee on an Official American Kennel Club Entry Form. Entries submitted in the form of telegrams or by telephone, cannot be accepted.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Judge, or barred from competition by action of the show committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entries fees for duplicate entry or overpayment of entry fees. If because of riots, civil disturbances, fire extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, and Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or another acts beyond the control of the Club or Show Secretary it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

AN ADMINISTRATIVE FEE OF \$2.00 will be charged for all cancellations or changes made prior to closing of entries.

ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under the American Kennel Club rules shall be allowed on the show grounds and dogs excused form further judging are to be removed promptly.

ALL DOGS SHALL BE held on leash or confined to their crates, except when being judged or when being exercised.

THERE SHALL BE NO drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises.

DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club and its Show Secretary will not be responsible and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

DOGS NEED TO BE AT THE SHOW only at scheduled time for judging and may leave immediately thereafter, unless require for further judging.

THE CLUB reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value,

ALL TROPHIES must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed or otherwise distributed.

CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the persons showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that Breed is over and the Show Secretary's Office is advised at once. The Show Secretary and Show giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the Breed is over.

THE WELFARE OF AN EXHIBITOR'S CHILD is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the show. For everyone's safety, no baby strollers or wheeled child carriers are allowed on the show grounds.

ALL PERSONS ATTENDING THIS DOG SHOW hereby waive any claim for damages against SAN DIEGO RHODESIAN RIDGEBACK CLUB, INC. its members, or agents, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

SAN DIEGO RHODESIAN RIDGEBACK CLUB, INC., IT'S SHOW SECRETARIES, THEIR AGENTS, EMPLOYEES, ETC.
